2009/0107 – Demolition of 3 buildings and replacement with 3 new buildings to Class B1 (Business) @ former LCC Countryside depot including improved access road and parking area including retention of existing yard and hard standing to rear for vehicle plant storage. An amended plan has now been submitted which reduces the height of the proposed buildings. This Council using the Clerks delegated authority previously supported resident concerns with regard to a number of issues particularly relating to the overall height of the buildings which have now been reduced.
