11. To consider the draft protocol to be used where a parish council wishes to consider undertaking devolved services and respond to the consultation paper if appropriate (enclosed)

To consider the report from LCC (enclosed) concerning potential road safety measures on Liverpool Rd, decide which options this Council would prefer to be taken forward and whether this Council might wish to contribute to ensure that all its preferences may be delivered. An allocation of 15k has been provided by Lancashire Locals to cover the costs of a pedestrian crossing.
