HUTTON PARISH COUNCIL CLERK'S REPORT (Information only) OCTOBER 2009

- It will have been noticed that works have been undertaken on Liverpool Rd /Tolsey Drive in response to continued pressure to alleviate the flooding issues that have been prevalent at this spot for some time.
- The Chairman and Clerk recently attended a briefing session at Hutton Police HQ where plans were announced to make alterations to their premises to improve and extend their office facilities for existing workers. A planning application is due to be submitted shortly.
- The Orchard Farm retrospective application finally made the last SRBC planning Committee meeting however the decision was deferred it is understood pending a transport assessment and further consultation with local residents. It is also understood that a request will go to the Area Committee for permission to issue enforcement proceedings for those current activities which are not part of the retrospective application which only covers a change of use for 'storage and distribution'
- Hutton was unsuccessful in the 2009 best Kept Village Competition. A copy of the judge's report has been requested.
- SRBC has adopted Dog Control Orders under the Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act 2005. The specific details are available from SRBC and notices have been placed around the district informing residents of the orders.
- The Dungeon Farm planning application relating to the production of compost is expected to be dealt with at the LCC Committee meeting in early November.
- The Grange Lane Garage application for a change of use has now been withdrawn.
- SRBC have agreed to extend the fencing at the corner of the playing field on the recreation ground as requested. The work is likely to take place alongside the improvement works around the Village Hall details of which are expected to be agreed shortly.
