HUTTON PARISH COUNCIL CLERK'S REPORT (Information only) SEPTEMBER 2009

- Planning application 2009/0107 relating to the erection of office buildings at the Countryside Services Depot Lindle Lane was finally approved by SRBC
- The new bus shelter on Liverpool Rd close to Lindle lane has been installed. A number of positive comments have been fed back to the Council
- The Lancashire Fire and Rescue Services Performance Report and Action Plan 2009 (171 pages) has been produced. There are two proposals contained in the section relating to the 2009 Emergency Cover Review which relate to new manning arrangements for some areas including Penwortham and the introduction of a new smaller purpose built fire engine for the Blackpool Station. The papers relating to the new manning arrangements are attached however please note that it states that there are no impacts on attendance times and the public will receive exactly the same service as at present. The report provides provision for public comment between now and the 9th November 2009. The full report can be obtained from the Fire and Rescue services web site. In addition the Clerk also holds one full copy.
- Priory High School planning application gets the go ahead and funding has been identified which will see the continuation of public leisure facilities during the day at the school. A relocated car park and fencing will provide the required child protection measures whilst other improvements will be undertaken including a multi use games area.
- The speed limit reduction on Liverpool Rd from Hutton roundabout to Saunders Lane has been approved and work will commence as soon as possible.
- Planning applications relating to Orchard Farm and Grange Lane Garage and now likely to be considered at the SRBC October Planning Committee Meeting. LCC have been asked to respond as a matter of urgency to the issues relating to traffic.
- Despite continued pressure the Council have not yet received any update with regard to flooding in the Tolsey Drive/Liverpool Rd area.
