Hutton Village Hall 1986 – 2011

Our village hall will be 25 years old at the beginning of May so lets celebrate!



It took over five years and lots of hard work to realise our dream of having a community meeting place in our own village. Hutton village hall was formerly opened on the 5th May 1986 by our then Member of Parliament Robert Atkins. We are pleased to announce that The Rt. Hon. Sir Robert Atkins M.E.P. and his wife Dulcie have accepted our invitation to open the 25th anniversary celebrations at the May Day Fête on Monday 2nd May.

Wouldn't it be great if we could replicate that tremendous community spirit when the whole village came together to take part in that fantastic day 25 years ago. Can we do it ?

These are just some of the ways you could help:-

New Ideas – We would welcome help now in the planning stages, especially from anyone with new ideas and the enthusiasm to realise them.

Raffle – Can you or your place of work donate a prize? Can you sell any raffle tickets to your family, friends or colleagues? Setting Up – As much as possible is done prior to May Day especially on the preceding Sunday but it really is “all hands on deck” on the Monday morning erecting tents, stalls etc. getting everything ready. Sunday or Monday you would be most welcome.

Clearing Up – This can be the hardest job of all. Everything has to be dismantled and put away. The hall has to be cleaned and reinstated – it is used the following day for regular bookings.

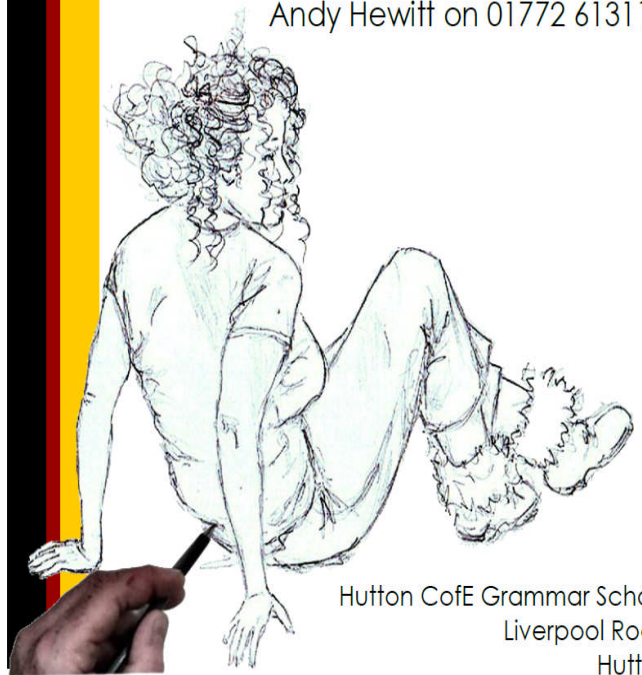
